SHAME

I recently listened then read a book by Brene Brown, called Daring Greatly. I thought the title sounded interesting, but didn't know what it was really about. Turns out it was about shame. The struggle that people have with shame, and some ways to cure it. As I listened, it kept coming to me that the solution she was looking for was found in Jesus and His Church. So that is how our Lent series got started.

The Bible uses the word "shame" 153 times, mostly describing people living ungodly lives. Shame excludes people from their group. People want to be part of a community. To be in a community is also to have some standards and to be honored for keeping them, and shamed for not. I know that sounds like a bad church to belong to, especially for being shamed for not keeping them.

But the point of church is that it is a place to remove our shame, to be included in a group, and to receive honor. In particular the honor of being called Children of God. Jesus suffered shame, so that he could bestow upon us his honor. "Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy set before him endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God." (Hebrews 12:2, NIV84)

If you struggle with shame, come hear how Jesus lifts you out of that, and gives you community, and life. If you are ashamed of something in your life, know that we come to church, and confess our sins, and so are all in the same boat. We all need our shame removed. Jesus does that. Read the Gospels, and see how Jesus took people that were shamed, and honored them. He does that for you too.
